- **1.** "Peter William Ingham, the fourth bishop of Wollongong, died peacefully in the late evening of 26 April 2024. He was 83 years of age and almost 60 years a priest."
- 2. "Living Hope Baptist Church in Corrimal called a new Senior Pastor on the 14th. Pastor Matt Douglas, who has served in the church almost 13.5 years, stepped down to take up a new role internationally and the church called the associate pastor Filip Laus as the new Senior Pastor. Pastor Fil and his wife Elly have two small children. He has been the associate pastor since May of last year with the intention of moving into the Senior pastor position when it became vacant. They come from Trinity Bible Church in Padstow."
