- **1. Hillsong Church Wollongong** has leased and moved into 15 Burelli St, the building previously owned by Lifeway Lutheran Church and purchased by Holy Cross Greek Orthodox Church earlier this year.

The 2024 Winter edition of "Vision", the official newsletter of Vision Christian Media, contains an error, which is unfortunately becoming more common, the word "ecumenism" was used where "pluralism", I think, was intended. The result is to criticise the effort of Christian churches towards greater visible unity, the work of the World Council of Churches, the National Council of Churches in Australia, the various state ecumenical councils, and the desire of Jesus Christ for unity among his followers (John 17). Christianity is exclusivist in the sense that it does not accept the ideology of religious pluralism, which accepts the views of diverse religions as equally valid. My forthcoming video, "Which God", will cover this topic and be added to the gospelfacts.au website in coming weeks.
